SECTION 5 – MALAYSIA MISCELLANEOUS MATERIAL

CHAPTER SEVENTY-ONE

SETEMKU (PERSONALISED) STAMPS.

Note: All illustrations in this chapter are reduced by 10% (50% for sheetlets and stationery) unless otherwise stated.

Terminology:

The term "Personalised sheet" is applied to sheets that are produced with blank labels to enable customers to have their own images of choice printed on them. From 2010, Pos Malaysia removed the line of perforations between stamp and label, presumably to prevent customers trying to use the labels as stamps. Blank sheets were not sold as they could be abused to incorporate images that could offend public morals or offend the authorities.

The term "Generic Sheet" is applied to sheets that are produced for sale with pre-printed labels to mark a specific event or celebration. So far as is known, the first generic sheet issued by Pos Malaysia was released to enable customers to mark Deepavali in October 2019.

Setemku (I) - Personalised stamps (Commercial).







Pos Malaysia launched four personalised stamp designs with labels, similar to the Singapore MyStamp issues, to be issued in sheets of 20 with decorative borders. (The brand name "Setemku" (Bahasa Malaysia for "My Stamp" and sometimes written "Setem Ku" as two words) was later adopted.) However, there was no evidence of any kind of public launch. Instead, their website appeared to be seeking Malaysian incorporated or publicly-listed corporate customers to invest in large scale orders (minimum 500 sheets) with high premia to be paid by the companies that place the first few orders (RM20,000 for the first to launch and RM10,000 for the next 10 companies), which would seem guaranteed to discourage customers. Although local information was that some large corporations had taken up these stamps for overseas mail, none have been seen by the author. A brochure dated January 2010 retained the 500 minimum order with a price of RM16 per 30s. sheet and RM26 per 50s. sheet. Discounts were offered for bulk purchases of 700-1000 sheets (5%), 1001-2000 (10%), 2001-3000 (15%) or 3001+ (20%).

The designer(s) was not recorded.

Philatelic Society of Malaysia was allowed to order a smaller quantity on behalf of its members with the society emblem (*illustrated above*) to mark the sixtieth anniversary of the society. These were released at the 2007 Merdeka Stamp Fair. 62 sheets of each value were produced. The description below is based on those sheets and reveals considerable complexity even in such a small run.

Counter sheets:

The four 28mm x 38mm designs came in both 30s. and 50s. versions and showed:

30s.(A) and 50s.(A): PC004 "National Icon" (hibiscus and flag);

30s.(B) and 50s.(B): PC001 "Malaysia in Cyberspace" (view of South East Asia from space with Malaysia highlighted, with satellite earth station);

30s.(C) and 50s.(C): PC003 "Environment" (lakeside gardens);

30s.(D) and 50s.(D): PC002 "Malaysia Flag".

(PC 001-004 were the Pos Malaysia official reference numbers for the designs.)

They were printed by Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography in 297mm x 210mm counter sheets of 20 (5 x 4) with (initially) blank stamp-sized labels to the right of the stamp and decorative borders following the theme of the stamps. From examination, the labels were probably overprinted using digital printing, although the high minimum number of sheets specified might suggest off-set lithography. Sheet markings were 1A (x4) above and below stamp column 1 and label column 5, colour dots to left and right of rows 1 and 4, Pos Malaysia emblem below label column 3. The paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. Watermark was Multiple SPM upright (30s. Design C, 50s. Designs B and C) or inverted (rest). Five 50s. Design C sheets in the PSM printing were found to have watermark inverted instead of the normal upright. The comb perforations measured 13.6 x 13.8 (30s. B-D, 50s. C seen) or 14.3 (30s. A, 50s. A, B, D seen). The broad top margins were imperforate and the bottom margins perforated through. The side margins may be imperforate at left (30s. C, 50s. C seen) or right (30s. D, 50s. C) and perforated through the other, or perforated through both sides (30s. A, B, 50s. A, B, D). The existence of 50s. C in two forms suggests that more than one pane was used on the printer's plate.

None were provided.

2007 (by October).

Setemku (II) - Personalised stamps (Private).

By October 2007, personalised stamps for use by private individuals were being advertised through the Pos Malaysia website, but no details were given other than that there were four designs:

- (A): SK001 Flower Bouquet;
- (B): SK002 Teddy Bear and balloons;
- (C): SK003 Hearts;
- (D): SK004 National Icon (identical to the business issue above).

Technical data is assumed to have been as for the business issue. Even the private scheme did not come cheap. Pos Malaysia offered three packages, each costing RM500!

- "Emerald" provided 34 sheets of twenty 30s. stamps.
- "Diamond" provided 12 sheets of 30s. and 13 sheets of 50s. stamps.
- "Ruby" provided 20 sheets of 50s. stamps.

Additional sheets were charged at RM13 for twenty 30s. stamps and RM22 for twenty 50s. stamps. Again, only the value changed - the designs were common to both values.

While the author has not seen any actual examples of these stamps, local information was that they were quite popular, particularly for wedding invitations in the Malay community. The Chinese community, on the other hand, would not have been likely to use them for this application as, traditionally, wedding invitations were personally delivered.

A Setemku brochure dated January 2011, gave the price of sheets as RM19 each for 30s. and RM28 each for 50s., without the need to purchase a package. These four designs were still those on offer.

31 August 2009.

Setemku (III) - National Day - Malaysian Unity (II) - One Malaysia.

Pos Malaysia briefly, and without announcement to account holders, issued a 28mm x 38mm 30s. personalised stamp based on counter sheet stamp design A (see issue 09.13), but without the map of Malaysia. It is assumed that it was designed by Hazel Design.

The stamps were printed in sheets of $20 (5 \times 4)$ with labels to the right of the stamps, similar to the format used for issue 07S.1, so that the same equipment and software could be used. In the example shown, the label intruded into the stamp area at the right.

Sheet markings were colour dots (x4) to left and right of rows 1 and 4, 1A (x4) above and below the stamp column 1 and label column 5, and Pos emblem below column 3. The paper was as used for the counter sheets. The stamps had watermark Multiple SPM upright and perforation 13.75 without ellipse. The top and bottom margins were imperforate with the left and right margins perforated through.



The personalisation service using this issue was not advertised on the Pos Malaysia website nor to account holders, and was only available for overprinting with a personal image of the applicant. Despite this restriction, some examples were offered on e-Bay in March 2010 overprinted with unauthorised pictures of Malaysian royalty. The personalised sheets were normally sold at RM19, but there was a special offer of RM6 for personal callers at the Kuala Lumpur Bureau early in 2010.

Setemku (IV) - Generic Sheet - One Malaysia - Deepavali.



Between 14 October and 5 November 2010, Pos Malaysia issued a generic sheet to celebrate the festival of Deepavali. It was sold at RM19. Unlike previous sheets, there was no label. Instead, the stamp was double width with a 60s. "1" stamp based on the 2009 30s. design (issue 09S.1 above)) at the left and the "Happy Deepavali" message at the right. With an unknown label designer, this issue comprised a single counter sheet.

Counter sheet:

The 56mm x 38mm counter sheet stamps showed:

60s.: One Malaysia stamp with Deepavali symbol at right.

They were printed in sheets of 10 (Single Ushaped row of stamps 4 x 4 with central area for a greeting message) Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography. Sheet markings were 1A (x4) above and below columns 1 and 4, colour dots (x4) to left and right of rows 1 and 4, Pos emblem below R4/2-3. The phosphorcoated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and



a yellow- green after-glow under ultra-violet light. The paper had watermark Multiple SPM sideways reading down. The harrow perforations measured 14.4.

First day facilities:

There was no known presentation pack, official first day cover or folder. The sheet was supplied in a black cardboard mount.

December 2010.

Setemku (V) - Generic Sheet - One Malaysia - Christmas and New Year.





During December 2010, Pos Malaysia issued generic sheets to celebrate the festivals of Christmas and New Year using the same One Malaysia basic sheet as the previous issue. They were each sold at RM19 in a pack with a plain white envelope with a 50s. 2005 flower stamp affixed to send it to a friend.

Designed by an unknown label designer, this issue comprised two counter sheets, the Christmas one having two setenant designs.

Counter sheets:

The 56mm x 38mm counter sheet stamps showed:

60s.(A): Christmas: One Malaysia personalised stamp design at left with Christmas tree at right (R1/1, 2/2, 3/1, 4/2, 4/4):

60s.(B): Christmas: One Malaysia personalised stamp design at left with snowflake at right (R1/2, 2/1, 3/2, 4/1, 4/3); 60s.(C): New Year: One Malaysia personalised stamp design at left with fireworks and 2011 in balloons at right.

They were printed in sheets of 10 (Single U-shaped row of stamps 4 x 4 with central area for a greeting message) by Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography. Design A appeared at R1/1, R2/4, R3/1, R4/2 and R4/4. Design B appeared at R1/2, R2/1, R3/2, R4/1 and R4/3. Sheet markings were as for the Deepavali issue. The message "Merry Christmas" or "Happy New Year" appeared with space for a message in the centre of the sheet. The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and a yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. The paper had watermark Multiple SPM sideways reading down. The harrow perforations measured 14.4.

First day facilities:

There was no known presentation pack, official first day cover or folder.

Each sheet was supplied in a black cardboard mount.

January 2011.

Setemku (VI) - Generic Sheet - One Malaysia - Chinese New Year.



During January 2011, Pos Malaysia issued a further generic sheet to celebrate the festival of Chinese New Year using the One Malaysia basic sheet. It is believed that they were sold at RM19, as in the case of that issue.

Designed by an unknown label designer, this issue comprised one counter sheet.

Counter sheets:

The 56mm x 38mm counter sheet stamps showed:

60s.(A): 1 and "Happy New Year" in Chinese characters with "2011" below;

60s.(B): 1 and a red rabbit covered with daisies and text "YEAR OF RABBIT 2011".

They were printed in sheets of 10 (Single U-shaped row of stamps 4 x 4 with central area for a greeting message) by Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography. Design A appeared at R1/1, R2/4, R3/1, R4/2 and R4/4. Design B appeared at R1/2, R2/1, R3/2, R4/1 and R4/3. Sheet markings were as for the Deepavali issue. The message "Gong Xi Fa Cai!" appeared with space for a message in the centre of the sheet. The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and a yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. The paper had watermark Multiple SPM sideways reading down. The harrow perforations measured 14.4.

First day facilities:

There was no known presentation pack, official first day cover or folder. Availability was limited; GPO Alor Star is reported to have received just five copies ¹.

Each sheet was supplied in a black cardboard mount.

28 April 2011.

Setemku (VII) -Generic Sheet - "New Edition".



The term "Setemku" appeared for the first time with this issue. This replaced the earlier issues. The face value was unusual as they were 5s. above the then-current postal rates. Like the earlier "One Malaysia" issues, the area for personalisation formed part of the stamp, instead of being a separate label.

Designed by Pictureworks (M) Sdn. Bhd., this issue comprised one generic counter sheet. Blank sheets for subsequent personalisation or generic use were also produced.

Counter sheets:

The 64mm x 27mm counter sheet stamps showed at the left-hand side (A) or right-hand side (B) stylised versions of:

35s.(A): Hibiscus (Bunga Raya) (R2/1, R4/1);

35s.(B): Durian (R2/2, R4/2);

65s.(A): Buckle-style handicraft, based on a wood carving (R1/1, R3/1);

65s.(B): Spiral design and Moon kite (Wau Bulan) (R1/2, R3/2).

On the generic sheet, the area at the other side of the stamp, normally left blank for personalisation, was occupied by images of the same objects crafted in silver. 1.5 million sheets were printed (this may include those printed with blank spaces

for personalised and other generic sheets).

They were printed in sheetlets of 8 (2 x 4) with two blocks of the four stamps by Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography. Sheet markings were areas at top and right for personal messages and the Pos emblem in the bottom right-hand corner. The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and a yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. The paper had watermark Multiple SPM sideways reading down. The comb perforations measured 13.8 x 14.1, a line 13.8 being used to close the bottom of the block without perforating through any margin.

First day facilities:

There was no presentation pack.

The first day cover, sold at 50s., featured the stamp designs.

The special first day postmark included elements of the four designs.

There was no folder.

This generic sheet, sold at RM20, had a green background with a night sky theme and was sold in a cellophane shop display bag in a card folder with a white envelope to which a stamp was affixed. That seen had an 80s. pet stamp. The sheet generated four different stamps:

35s.(A): Hibiscus plus (incense?) burner;

35s.(B): Durian plus woven parcels;

65s.(A): Buckle plus woven parcels;

65s.(B): Spiral plus burner.

This generic sheet, sold at RM20, had a red background with a dragon theme and was sold in a cellophane shop display bag in a card folder with a white envelope to which a stamp was affixed. Those seen had either an 80s. pet stamp or an aviation 80s. stamp (the latter said to be unusual). The sheet generated eight different stamps:

- 35s.(B): Hibiscus plus short Chinese character resembling reversed "N";


Upin & Ipin (18 September 2012-January 2013).

This generic sheet, sold at RM26, followed on from the 2010 Traditional Games issues with the cartoon characters Upin and Ipin. This was the first of five issues, sold at RM26 (generic) or RM35 (personalised). The personalised side of each stamp showed a character in a traditional costume. It was sold in a cellophane shop display bag with a card folder. The sheet was also available for personalisation. The sheet generated eight different stamps:

- 35s.(A): Hibiscus plus Bidayuh fighting costume.
- 35s.(B): Durian plus "Sam Foo" (Chinese Lion costume).
- 35s.(C): Hibiscus plus Malay dress, hobby horse and eartheware pot.
- 35s.(D): Durian plus Malay dress and moon kite.
- 65s.(A): Buckle plus Upin in Traditional Baba and Nyonya costume with fan.
- 65s.(B): Spiral plus Malay dress playing spinning top.
- 65s.(C): Buckle plus Upin in "Dhotti" (Tamil costume) and lamps.
- 65s.(D): Spiral plus Iban bird costume wwith blowpipe and Hornbill.

The five issues had different themes for the background of the right-hand panel, plus, on the generic version, different label images:

- 1. 18 September 2012 (generic issue [illustrated]): Buildings.
- 2. October 2012: Fruit.



This generic sheet, sold at RM20, had a red background with a snowflake theme and was sold in a cellophane shop display bag in a card folder with a white envelope to which a stamp was affixed. That seen had an 80s. environment stamp. The sheet generated eight different stamps:

35s.(A): Hibiscus plus tree.



The third series of Setemku (MyStamp) issues for Malaysia was launched with generic sheets. Designed by Reign Associates, this issue comprised a generic se-tenant and four personalised single-design sheets for "Corporate" use and the same for "Individual" use.

Counter sheets:

The stamps appeared in two forms. The 50mm x 30mm stamps on sheets for personalisation were printed at the left but blank at the right so that the personal image could be incorporated. Each design appeared on a separate sheet of 10 (2 x 5), sold for RM19. On the generic sheets of 8 stamps (2 x 4), the common design at the left was extended to fill the whole stamp and all the designs appeared on composite sheets, one for each group of four designs. The sequence of designs in the upper and lower halves of the sheet was reversed, so that the designs also formed vertical strips of four. 500,000 of each generic sheet stamp design were printed. The stamps showed:

"Corporate" sheets:

60s.(A): Flora & Fauna (Rafflesia and Rajah Brooke's Birdwing);

60s.(B): Flag (Malaysian flag flying over hibiscus flowers);

60s.(C): Batik (floral design);

They were printed by Percetakan Keselamatan Nasional using standard four-colour off-set lithography. Sheet markings on the generic sheets were the issue title in the top margin, 1A (x4) to left of R1 and right of R4/2, colour dots (x4) to right of R1/2 and left of R4/1, Pos emblem below left column on Individual sheets or right column on Corporate sheets. The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and a yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. It had watermark Multiple SPM sideways reading down. The comb perforations measured 13.7 x 13.4.


The Design 3 stamp was 36mm x 51mm with pre-printed text at top and bottom and an illustration of flowers and the Petronas Twin Towers at the left, leaving a large empty space for a portrait-format illustration.

They were printed, possibly by Pos Malaysia, using standard four-colour lithography or digital printing in sheets of 10 (4 x 4 with positions R2-3/1-2 occupied by a blank area for a large image). Sheet markings (portrait format) were Pos emblem and "Setemku" above R1/1, colour dots (x4) to left of R1/1 and right of R4/4, 1A (x4) to right of R1/4 and left of R4/1, "Pos Malaysia Berhad (229990-M) | www.pos.com.my | 1 300 300 300" below R4/1-3. The paper used varied from issue to issue. The sheets were harrow perforated 14.5.

Landscape-format Design 4 had the text at the bottom and orchid at the right, with the stamps arranged down the sides and across the bottom of the sheet.

10 July 2018. Tun Dr. Mahathir.





To mark the 93rd Birthday of Tun Dr. Mahathir, the newly re-elected Prime Minister, Pos Malaysia used Setemku (VI) Design 3 to produce a pack containing three sheetlets, which was sold in a folder at RM93. The sheet used two stamp designs of Tun Dr Mahathir in formal dress that alternated around the sheet. Design A showed him writing and B reading. The large photographs showed him with his wife, Tun Dr. Siti Hasmah. The photographs were credited to Norman Goh, Alexio Yeoh, Tara Sosrowardoya and Bernama. 100,000 were printed of each sheet design.

The unwatermarked paper gave a low yellow-green fluorescent reaction under UV, but each stamp was overprinted with a vertical yellow-green phosphor band which fluoresced strongly and gave an afterglow under UV.

Setemku - Marvel 80th Anniversary.

This issue marked the 80th Anniversary of Marvel Comics and features characters from the "Marvel Avengers" universe. The folder contained three Setemku sheets, two unstamped postcards and two pre-serviced first day covers. In addition, two process sheets were produced to make-up the first day covers.

Sheet A:

This 148mm x 210mm sheet showed an assembly of Avengers characters and contained a single "Illusion" design stamp bearing the event emblem (60s.(A)). It was printed by five-colour off-set lithography (standard plus silver). The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultraviolet light. The sheet was imperforate.



Sheet B:

This 148mm x 210mm sheet contained five "Illusion" design stamps bearing images of leading Marvel characters: (top to bottom)

60s.(B): Thor; 60s.(C): Iron Man; 60s.(D): Captain America;

60s.(E): Thanos;

60s.(F): The Incredible Hulk.

It was printed by five-colour off-set lithography (standard plus silver). The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultra-violet light. The sheet was Harrow perforated 14.6.



Sheet C:

This 148mm x 210mm sheet contained five more "Illusion" design stamps bearing images of leading Marvel characters: (top to bottom)

60s.(G): Loki; 60s.(H): Spiderman; 60s.(I): Black Panther; 60s.(J): Doctor Strange; 60s.(K): Black Widow.

It was printed by five-colour off-set lithography (standard plus silver). The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultra-violet light. The sheet was Harrow perforated 14.6.



Process sheets:

The stamps from sheets A and B were also printed as se-tenant strips of five stamps (D-B-C-E-F, H-G-I-K-J) in one or two process sheets in order to assist the production of pre-serviced first day covers.

First day facilities:

Two similar first day covers were produced with the same overall design. That used for Sheet B had a white background and a red flap. That use for sheet C had a grey background and white flap.

The special first day postmark showed the Marvel Comics emblem.



Setemku - Batman 80th Anniversary.

This issue marked the 80th Anniversary of DC Comics' Batman character and features images from comics over that period. There were two packs. A pack containing a miniature sheet in a card folder and envelope was sold for RM10. The RM120 pack was a folder containing three Setemku sheets, two unstamped postcards and three pre-serviced first day covers. In addition, two process sheets were produced to make-up the first day covers.

Miniature sheet:

This 140mm x 80mm sheet contained three 80s. stamps showing Batman in different styles of animation:

80s.(A): Early (yellow background);

80s.(B): Mid-period (orange background);

80s.(C): Recent (dark background).

Unlike previous issues in this Setemku series, the border pattern was omitted to allow the stamp design to extend to the full dimensions of the stamp. The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultra-violet light. The sheet was Harrow perforated 14.6.




Tear-off postcard:

The cover of the folder in which the miniature sheet was sold was perforated at the hinge and designed to be torn-off and used as a postcard. It had seven scenes and the oval Batman emblem.

Generic Sheet A:

This 176mm x 249mm sheet showed a composite of Batman images making up the head profile and contained a single "Illusion" design stamp bearing the event emblem applied by hotstamped plastic foil (80s.(D)). It was printed by five colour off-set lithography (standard plus silver). The phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultra-violet light. The sheet was Harrow perforated 14.6.

Process sheets:

The stamps from sheets B and C were also printed as se-tenant strips of five stamps (E-F-G-H-I, J-K-L-M-N) in one or two process sheets in order to assist the production of pre-serviced first day covers.

First day facilities:

Three different first day covers were produced with the same overall design. That used for Sheet A had a full size batman image, while the other two had smaller images to avoid being covered by the stamps.

The special first day postmark showed the Batman oval emblem.

Setemku - Star Wars IX- The Rise of Skywalker.

This issue revealed the ultimate Setemku option, eliminating even a vestigial border design. The Setemku emblem was retained at the top of each stamp, with Malaysia and the value at the bottom. The stamps were issued in two packs released to coincide with the launch of the ninth and last film in the main Star Wars saga.

Pack A: Miniature sheet:

Sold in a card folder and envelope for RM10, this 140mm x 80mm miniature sheet contained three 36mm x 51mm 90s. stamps showing:

90s.(A): Robot D-O BB-8;

90s.(B): Robot R2-D2;

90s.(C): Robot C-3PO.

They were printed by an unknown printed using offset-lithography on phosphor-coated paper that gave a greenish-white fluorescence and yellow-green afterglow under ultra-violet light. It was perforated 14.6.



Pack B: Folder set:







The annual Chinese New Year Setemku sheet has migrated to the 2017 Setemku series.

This issue comprised one Setemku sheet, an unstamped postcard and an unstamped envelope.

Setemku sheet:

The 35mm x 50mm stamps showed Chinese characters in different fonts and colours on Design 1 (Illusion) background stamps:

60s.(A): Shu - Tikus in yellow on red (R1/1);

60c.(B): Fu - Kemakmuran in red on blue (R1/2, R4/1);

60s.(C): Shu - Tikus in blue on green (R1/3, R4/2);

60c.(D): Fu - Kemakmuran in yellow on red (R1/4, R4/3);

60s.(E): Shu - Tikus in red on blue (R2/1); 60c.(F): Fu - Kemakmuran in blue on green (R3/1);

60s.(G): Shu - Tikus in red on blue in box (R4/4).

They were printed in sheets of 10 (4 x 4 including large label) by an unknown printer. Sheet markings were as previously described for this Setemku series. Unlike the Mahathir issue, the unwatermarked, phosphor-coated paper gave a greenish-white fluorescent reaction and a yellow-green after-glow under ultra-violet light. The harrow perforations measured 14.5.

The sheet was sold at RM25 by itself, or in a folder with three matching envelopes and two postcards was sold at RM38.


